## **Nunavut Arctic College Language Policy**

### **POLICY**

Inuktitut and English are the languages of learning and work at Nunavut Arctic College.

### **PROCEDURES**

#### Instructional:

- 1. The goal of the course and program determine the language of instruction.
- 2. Students in all credit programs will be required to complete an Inuktitut/Inuinnaqtun language course for credit as a requirement for program completion.
- 3. The level of the course determines the level of the language used for instruction.
- 4. Correctness of language is decided by the President's Office on the recommendation of the Language and Cultural Committee.
- 5. Supplemental instruction is available in both languages.
- 6. Students taking exams in their second language are granted an appropriate amount of extended time.

### Administrative and Support Services:

- 7. Student services, such as counseling, library, registrar and residence, are available in both languages.
- 8. Services for individuals making enquiries or seeking assistance is available in both languages.
- 9. Official meetings may be conducted in both languages depending on the choice of the participants. Translation into the other language must be provided.
- 10. Corporate identity on signs, letterhead, and other media uses both languages with Inuktitut in the first position.

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
