## **Nunavut Arctic College Convocation**

## **POLICY**

Nunavut Arctic College shall hold Convocation ceremonies at each campus for students who successfully meet the requirements for a Nunavut Arctic College Certificate or Diploma.

## **PRINCIPLES**

- 1. Nunavut Arctic College recognizes that Convocation is a public recognition of the successful completion of the specified requirements for Certificate and / or Diploma level programs as published in the approved Nunavut Arctic College Program Outlines.
- 2. The College recognizes that due to scheduling constraints, some students may have additional course work to complete immediately following Convocation.

# **PROCEDURE**

- 1. Students who successfully complete their Program requirements and have achieved a cumulative average of "C" (60%) or higher prior to convocation will be recognized in convocation ceremonies (refer to Policy C.20 Student Academic Evaluation).
- 2. Full-time students in good standing and on the recommendation of the Dean who have courses to complete and who are registered in those courses in the semester of convocation may be permitted to participate in the convocation ceremonies
- 3. Certificates, diplomas and transcripts will not be issued until such time that all outstanding accounts with Arctic College are paid in full.
- 4. It is the student's responsibility to pay for travel to attend convocation.
- 5. The Dean or designate may choose to recognize non-certificate and non-diploma graduates during convocation at his/her discretion. Academic regalia should not be worn by those participants in these circumstances.
