Nunavut Arctic College Scholarships and Awards

POLICY

The College encourages and recognizes distinguished achievements of individual College students. This is done through scholarships, awards and other prizes.

PRINCIPLES

- 1. Nunavut Arctic College recognizes the achievements of individual College students through scholarships, bursaries and awards.
- 2. The College encourages each student to strive for excellence in all aspects of student life.
- 3. Nunavut Arctic College encourages private, public and corporate donors

PROCEDURE

- 1. The College encourages private donors, organizations and College Program staff to participate in scholarships, awards and prizes by establishing and maintaining an ongoing program of monetary and non-monetary support for scholarships, awards and prizes.
- 2. Scholarships, awards and prizes that impact on more than one Campus shall be administered through the Senior Academic Officer.
- 3. Each Campus shall establish an ad hoc Scholarship and Awards Committee which will determine the recipients of cross-departmental scholarships, awards and other prizes, as well as establishing how and when scholarships and awards are presented.
- 4. The Committee's decisions in determining the recipients of scholarships, awards and other prizes shall be final.
- Individual students can refuse any scholarship, award or prize. The refusal must be in writing. In such cases the College will recognize the next best qualified person, unless the terms specifically deny this.
