Nunavut Arctic College Academic Year

POLICY

The academic year shall commence on July 1 in one calendar year and terminate on June 30 in the following calendar year. A complete academic year schedule will be set annually.

PRINCIPLES

- 1. Nunavut Arctic College recognizes that a standard academic year is required to ensure proper program planning for College students, staff clients and partners.
- 2. The College recognizes that its students are drawn from all regions of Nunavut and possibly from other territories and provinces and make every effort to coordinate holiday breaks to allow air travel.
- 3. The College recognizes that, to meet the needs of its partners in education, there must be exceptions to the standard academic year.

PROCEDURES

- 1. The academic year for the College shall have four (4) terms / semesters:
 - a. Summer Term July to August
 - b. Fall Term September to December
 - c. Winter Term January to Aprild. Spring Term May to June
- 2. The Senior Academic Officer will, in February of each year, establish a schedule for the succeeding academic year. This will be done in conjunction with Deans.
- 3. The exact dates of each term may vary annually and will be published in the College Calendar.
- 4. The schedule for the academic year will be approved by the President.
