Nunavut Arctic College Students with Disabilities

POLICY

Nunavut Arctic College shall endeavour to accommodate student(s) with disabilities.

PRINCIPLES

1. Nunavut Arctic College strives to provide individuals with disabilities every opportunity to participate fully in the College's programs and services.
2. The College encourages individuals with disabilities, who are considering attending College, to notify the appropriate Dean prior to application for admission.

PROCEDURES

1. The Calendar and program outlines will clearly list pre-requisites required to successfully complete the program.

AT THE TIME OF APPLICATION

1. An applicant who requires that special conditions are available to him/her because of a known disability or condition must, at the time of application:
 - a. Identify his/her specific requirements, and
 - b. Demonstrate his/her ability to undertake program activities
2. Upon receipt of an application from an individual with disabilities, the Dean or designate will initiate appropriate measures to meet the specific needs of the applicant.
3. A meeting shall be held between the program staff and the Dean or designate to discuss any necessary advance arrangements when required.
4. Once an applicant has met all requirements for admission and is accepted into the program the advance arrangements will be implemented.

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DURING COURSE DELIVERY

1. Following admission to the College, if the student is assessed with a disability, the staff and student will work together to establish a plan conducive to creating a positive learning environment.
2. Where required elements of a program or course may be prohibitive to students with disabilities, the College will make attempts, wherever possible, to identify alternative equivalent activities which provide the students with the opportunity to fulfill the requirements.
